India's exports mainly consist of drugs & pharmaceuticals, plastic & linoleum products and manmade fibers.

Scholarships:

For academic year 2016-17, 02 slots have been allotted under ITEC whereas 9 Scholarship slots have been provided under ICCR.

Grants/Credits:

Refurbishment of a healthcare centre in Cabo Verde was financed by an IBSA grant. GOI has offered a Line of Credit of US\$ 5 million for setting up of a Technology Park Project in Cabo Verde. An assistance of US\$ 50,000/- was also extended by GOI in 2010 to the Government of Cape Verde to fight dengue fever. In October 2012, Indian Government provided assistance in the form of supply of computers for the Cabo Verde Government's programme 'A New World'.

India-Africa Forum Summit III:

Special Envoy of Prime Minister (SEPM) and Minister of State for Rural Development, Shri. Sudarshan Bhagat visited Cabo Verde in September, 2015 to personally invite the Cabo Verde delegation to participate in India Africa Forum Summit III (IAFS-III). Cabo Verde delegation headed by Foreign Minister Mr. Tolentini Araujo Jorge participated in IAFS-III from 26-29th October 2015.

2nd International Day of Yoga:

Embassy of India on 26 June 2016, organized a grand event in Praia to celebrate 2nd IDY. The event was attended by more than 100 persons including members of Indian diaspora, dignitaries and local Government officials, celebrities, diplomats and local people.
